



Lincoln's Life Mattered Foundation Memorial Scholarship

Purpose:

The Lincoln's Life Mattered Foundation Memorial Scholarship supports students pursuing post-secondary education in fields aligned the Foundation's mission. This scholarship aims to reduce the financial burden of higher education for deserving students.

Eligibility criteria; Applicants must:

- Be a current Grade 12 student graduating from Greenall High School **OR** a current post-secondary student.
- Have been accepted into a college, university, or accredited school for the 2026/2027 academic year.
- Be pursuing studies in a field that aligns with the Foundation's mission (e.g., psychology, social work, medicine, policing, EMT, nursing, fire services). However, students from faculties are encouraged to apply.
- Demonstrate a commitment to making a positive impact in their community.

Award Details:

- Ten (10) scholarships of \$1000.00 each will be awarded.

Application Must Submit:

A. Contact information:

- First and Last name
- Email Address
- Contact Number
- If applicant is under 18 years of age, provide name and contact information for legal guardian

B. Proof of acceptance and enrollment from the post-secondary institution

C. A 1–3-minute video answering: *“How do you plan to carry forward Lincoln's legacy by making a difference in your own community?”*

- In the video include any information that you would like to share about yourself.
- Include your full name in the video.



Video Submission Guidelines:

- **Maximum length:** 3 minutes
- **Maximum file size:** 15 MB
- **If your file exceeds 15MB,** please provide a shareable link in the field below. Ensure links are public and viewable by outside parties (us).

D. Short answer questions: Answers are limited to one page for all 3 questions.

1. **How will this scholarship help you?**

Explain how the scholarship will help you in at least one of the following ways: financially, professionally, and/or academically.

2. **Mental Health and Community Impact**

What do mental health and mental wellness mean to you? How have you contributed to your community?

3. **Academic and Career Aspirations**

What are your academic and/or career goals, and how do they align with the Foundation's vision and goals?

Be clear and concise. Explain what you want to study, and then what kind of career you want to lead afterwards. Explain why you're motivated to pursue that path.

Important Dates:

- Application deadline: **June 15, 2026 (midnight)**
- Application review: **Up to June 25, 2026**
- Recipient notification: **By June 26, 2026**

Selection & Notification:

- Winners will be selected by an independent panel, appointed by the Lincoln's Life Mattered Foundation Board of Directors.
- You will receive an email that your application has been received.
